Awareness Ribbons

Gold Ribbon :

Meaning: This colour is a symbol for childhood cancer

Purple Ribbon :

Meaning: This colour is a symbol of pancreatic cancer, testicular cancer, thyroid cancer, domestic violence, ADD, Alzheimer's, religious tolerance, animal abuse, the victims of 9/11 including the police and firefighters, Crohn's disease and colitis, cystic fibrosis, lupus, leiomyosarcoma, fibromyalgia and Sarcoidosis

Red Ribbon :

Meaning: Most commonly associated with the fight against AIDS and HIV, this ribbon also is a symbol for heart disease, stroke, substance abuse, MADD, DARE, Epidermolysis Bullosa, Reflex Sympathetic Dystrophy

Green Ribbon :

Meaning: This colour is a symbol of childhood depression, missing children, open records for adoptees, environmental concerns, kidney cancer, tissue/organ donation, homeopathy, and worker and driving safety

The colours in the Bible and their meanings

Gold - Glory, Divinity, Kingship, Eternal Deity, foundation, altar, beauty, precious, Holiness, Majesty, righteousness.

Purple - Priesthood, Kingship, Royalty, mediator, wealth.

Red - Blood of Jesus, love of God, blood of lamb, atonement, salvation.

Green - Praise, growth, prosperity, new beginning, flourishing, restoration.
